- Start with one of the following at **Placement and Testing Services, B142**:
 - placement using **ACCUPLACER**
 - domestic high school transcript, less than two years old, and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - appropriate grade in a high school English course, less than two years old, and within the Bellevue, and Snoqualmie Valley School Districts only—see Testing Services website for placement grids
 - appropriate scores on AP or IB exams, less than two years old
 - Smarter Balanced Language Art score of 3 or 4, may be used in the year following HS graduation, or for Running Start students
 - placement from another Washington State Community or Technical college (reciprocity), less than two years old
