■ ABE English

- Learn basic math, geometry and algebra
- Read and analyze data, charts and graphs

HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION (HSC) COURSES:

■ High School 21+ Program

- Complete your high school diploma through Bellevue College courses
- Eligible applicants must be 21 years of age or older
- Life experience can be used to earn additional credits toward a high school diploma (employment, parenting classes, job certifications or trainings)

■ GED® Preparation Course

- Review and prepare for the four GED® test
- Develop test-taking strategies and study skill

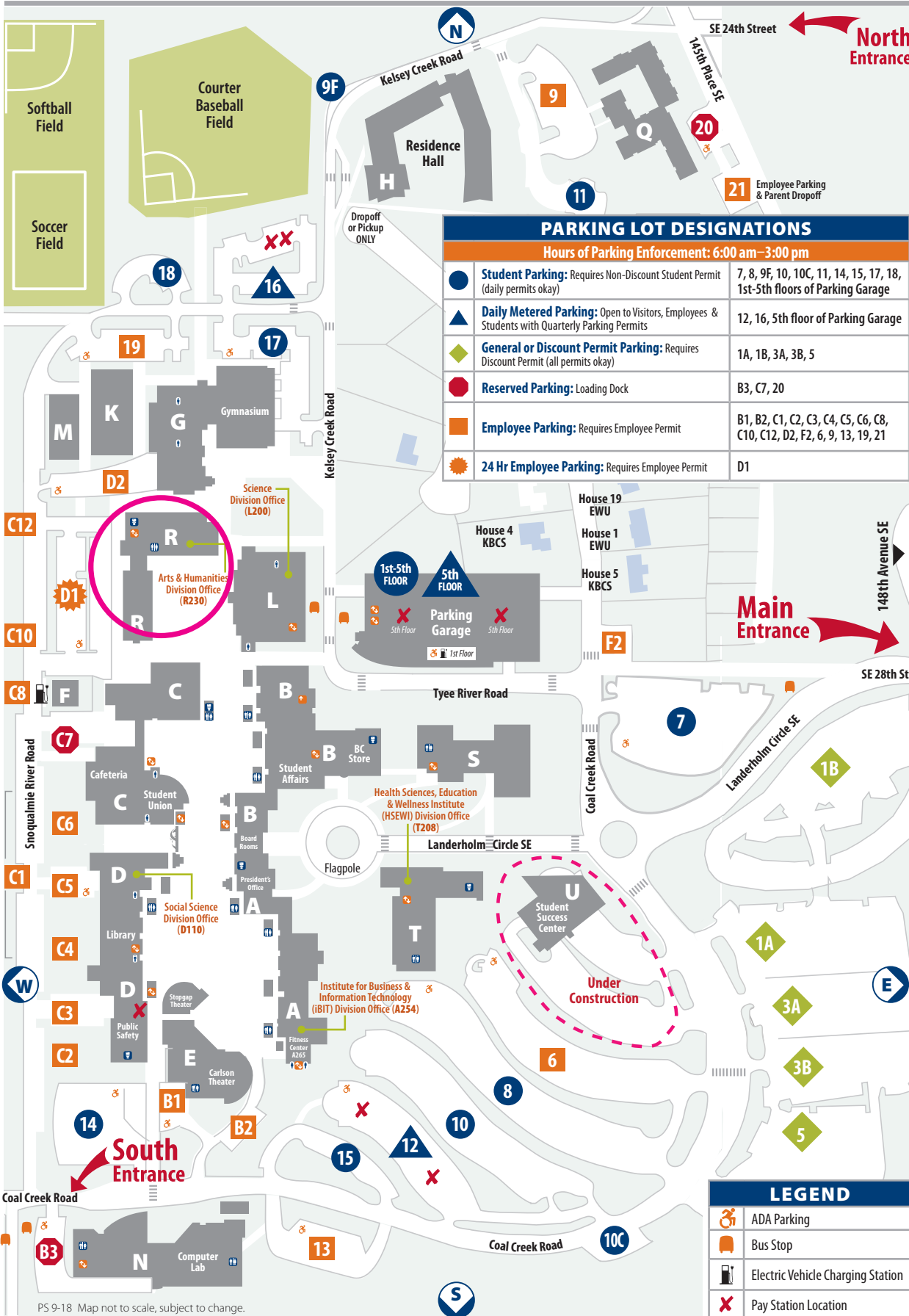
Main Campus Parking Map
